

Hello, Salt Lakers!

Big changes are coming to Ballpark–and the community's vision is at the heart of it! Three exciting design concepts for the Ballpark site were shared with the Redevelopment Agency Board today. These options aim to turn the area into a buzzing hub that meets the community's needs based on input from neighbors.

Here's how we got here:

Ballpark NEXT Design Competition: In 2023, we invited residents, students, and professionals to submit ideas for the future of Ballpark. Out of 123 submissions, three winning ideas helped shape the vision of the designs we are now considering.

Community Visioning Process: Last year, Salt Lake City worked alongside residents and key partners to create the Ballpark NEXT Guiding Principles, a set of values that reflect the community's desires to guide the development moving forward.

With this strong foundation in place, **the three bold design ideas are**:







Preserve

Activity and Sports as the Core: This scenario keeps the Ballpark Field as a

Adaptive Reuse

Arts and Culture: This scenario transitions the Ballpark into a hub for arts

Completely Rebuild

Ecology and Nature as the Focus: This scenario celebrates the natural centerpiece, transforming it into a year-round venue for professional, amateur, and community sports. A regulation soccer field could expand the site's versatility. and culture. The western segment of the stadium could be preserved and retrofitted as a venue for performances and community events. environment by partially daylighting the three creeks beneath 1300 South and embedding park spaces throughout the site.

These ideas are a direct result of the community's input. We will share a final plan in early 2025. Stay tuned for more updates!
