## **Cottonwood Park**

ENGAGEMENT REPORT | JUNE 2024









### **Project Background**

Using funds from the Parks, Trails, & Open Space General Obligation Bond (GO Bond), approved in November 2022, Cottonwood Park will be "reimagined" to better reflect neighborhood needs and identities. This project may include adding amenities that highlight the neighborhood's character and history, make the space more welcoming and enjoyable, and easier to navigate through multilingual signage.

With Cottonwood Park being located along the Jordan River corridor, our public engagement strategy will incorporate the vision of the Emerald Ribbon Action Plan, while also considering the site-specific public input collected during all phases of community engagement.



### **About the Park**

Cottonwood Park is located along the Jordan River in the Fairpark neighborhood in Council District 1. The park has a playground, restroom, cricket pitch, half basketball court, jogging/walking path, sand volleyball court, pavilions, picnic tables, and an off-leash dog area.



### **Public Engagement**

Phase 1 of public engagement aimed to understand the current use of the park, desired improvements, and values of the community.



### **Engagement Summary**



69% of survey respondents live in 84116, which encompasses the neighborhoods surrounding Cottonwood Park. Of those respondents, 56% are visiting the park on a weekly basis.



### **Engagement Summary**

#### **Desired Enhancements**



**Improved safety** – Lighting, bridge repair, removal of abandoned buildings, increased waste management.



**Cohesive park design** – The abandoned agriculture state building separates the park, particularly making the dog park feel disconnected from the rest of the park.



**Improved dog park** – Water features, agility course, area for large and small dog area, signage of rules.




**Passive features -** Improved walking loop, diversified landscape, seating areas, and shade structures.



**Recreational features** – Fitness equipment, bike park, skate park, pickleball courts, toddler play area.

The dog park receives a lot of love from its users who appreciate its spaciousness, abundance of trees, and picnic tables. Visitors also enjoy utilizing the adjacent trail for walking or biking.

#### **Overall Rating**

4.3 out of 5

#### **Desired Improvements**

Visitors want separate areas for small and large dogs and better integration of the dog park with the rest of the park. Safety and cleanliness are top concerns, especially by the river and restroom.

"The park is beautiful. It's a shame that there is so much garbage laying around, broken bottles, and food just on the ground. Also, there are homeless camps set up by the waters edge. Like I said, the park is beautiful but I wouldn't tell people visiting to come here." – Google Reviewer



### **Next Steps**

Public Lands staff will consult with technical experts, landscape architects, and maintenance supervisors to create a concept design that reflects the feedback gathered from the first phase of community engagement. The concept design will be presented to the community at the Emerald Ribbon Action Plan public workshops in the summer of 2024.












