

# Site Plan

## Legend

- 1 Promenade**  
 Event-friendly pathway accommodating food trucks and community events. The 20' wide promenade accommodates up to eight food trucks with power pedestals, accent paving, an alley of deciduous shade trees and seating.
- 2 Mist Fountain Plaza**  
 The primary entry space features natural stone slab seating and cooling misting features.
- 3 Promenade Gardens**  
 A space for respite, the gardens feature native and adaptive plants highlighting the regions natural landscape. The soft paths feature a series of six interpretive signs that highlight the rich and storied history of Pioneer Park.
- 4 Pavilion**  
 The iconic, open-air pavilion anchors the north end of the park as a space for seating and events, similar to the historic bowery that was in the park.
- 5 Restrooms, Maintenance and Ranger Building**  
 On axis with the park pavilion, the building provides visitor support, maintenance storage, and offices for Park Rangers. The four seasonal and one accessible year-round restroom support daily users and increases the desirability as a community event venue. The maintenance storage room and offices for Park Rangers allows for regular presence of park staff.
- 6 Inclusive and Accessible Playground**  
 Nestled into a shadier area of the park, the inclusive and accessible playground features age-specific play equipment on poured-in-place safety surfacing, misting poles and lawn under existing mature deciduous trees.
- 7 Pickleball Courts**  
 Six lit, recreational pickleballs courts with competition level surfacing on post-tension concrete per USA Pickleball standards.
- 8 Basketball Court**  
 One lit, full-size basketball court on post-tension concrete.
- 9 Dog Park**  
 Separate off-leash areas for low energy and high energy dogs includes a modest shade structure, dog drinking fountains, seating and a mix of crushed stone and synthetic turf.
