## Eligible Cargo & Utility E-Bike Models

The following styles of cargo & utility bikes are available to program participants:

- 1) **Rear Cargo:** Rear-load bikes handle similarly to a standard bike, although storage capacity may be more limited while carrying passengers.
- 2) Front Cargo: Offers the most cargo space of any design and a view of passengers while riding. Note: It may take time to adjust to the feel of steering.
- 3) Utility: These bikes have similar dimensions to a standard bike but have reinforced frames and special accessories allow them to carry heavier loads.
