WORK ACTIVITIES

- Last week, crews completed installing a new sewer line along the southwest area of the project limits, near the Millcreek City boundary.
- Crews continue to replace the aging water line between 2700 South and Stratford Avenue. The new water line is expected to be operational by mid-July.
- Crews will begin installing a new storm drain and water line this week on the north end of the project limits, between 2700 South and Parley's Canyon Boulevard. This installation is expected to continue through the end of June.
- After the installation of the water line and storm drain, crews will
 pulverize the north end of the project limits. This is scheduled to begin
 in early July.
